Friday 3rd April, Road Criterium

Race details:

- All Race categories will cover multiple laps the 1.49 mile loop.
- Race duration will be 45 mins for Advanced, Sport, Juniors and ladies.
- Race duration for Ladies Novice will be 20 minutes

Course details.

The Race Sign On and the Start and Finish line is on La Joanneuse Rd about 200 m before the main car park. The proceeds North and continues past the gold club continuing onto Les Hures and past the loophole tower. The road will be closed to vehicle traffic along the narrow section of the road, up and over the small hill and until the junction with Mont Cuet Rd. Riders turn left at the junction onto Mont Cuet Rd (at 0.75 miles). The course continues in a SE direction to L'Accresse cross roads. (1.33 miles). The course turns left at the cross roads and continues North to the Finish Line (1.49 miles).

The days Schedule:

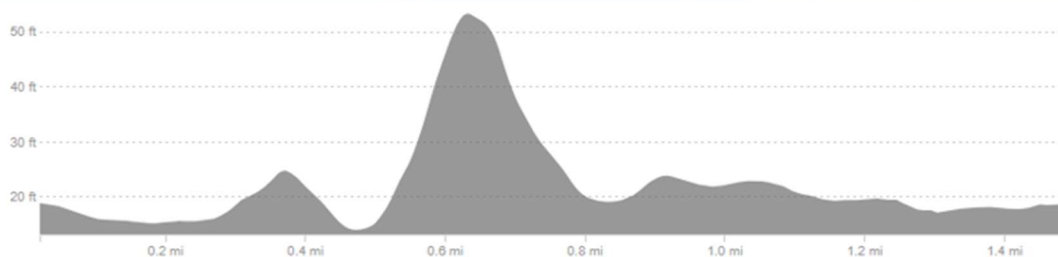
06:30 Sign on opens.

06:50 Sign on closes

07:00 Race start for Advanced, Sport, Juniors and Ladies categories. There will be a one minute gap between the start of Advanced / Junior men and Sport men / Ladies.

07:50 Race start for Novice Ladies.

Saturday 4th April, Petit Bot Hillclimb

Race Details:

- Hill Climb up the East side of Petit Bot.
- Race length, 0.23 miles for Novice Ladies, 0.36 miles all other categories.
- Starting order will be by category: U16/U14, Ladies, Sport Men, Junior Men, Advanced Men, Novice Ladies.
- The starting order for riders within each category will be the reverse order of their finishing positions in the Crit. The starting order for the U16/U14 riders will be by a random section.

Course details:

The Race HQ is at the bottom of Petit Bot, the Start Line is at the beginning of the climb up the East side of Petit Bot. After 0.23 miles and at the junction with the Rue de la Fallaise is the finish line for the Novice Ladies category. All other categories will turn right onto Rue de la Fallaise to the finish line at 0.36 miles.

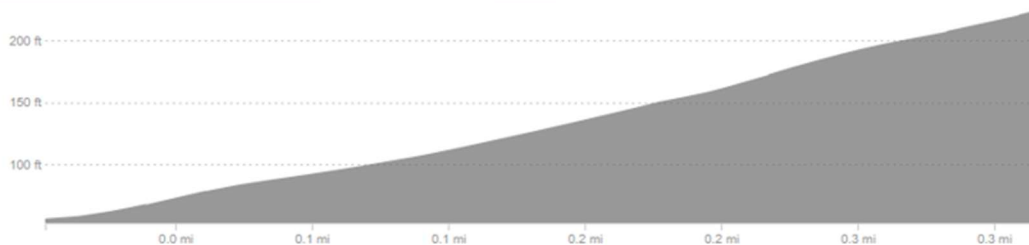
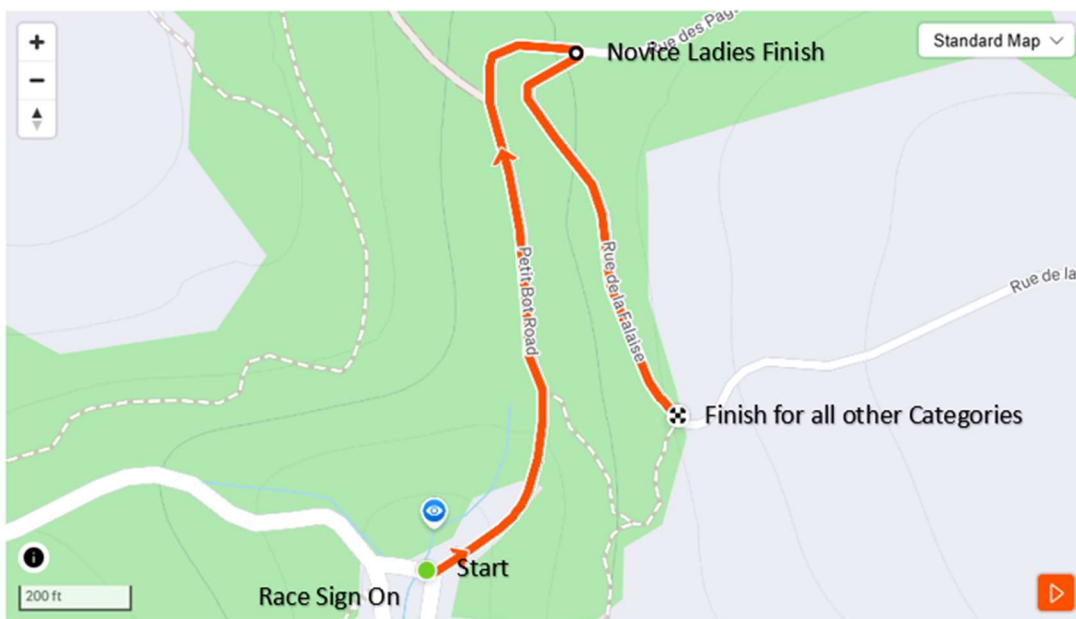
The days Schedule:

06:30 Sign on opens.

06:30 – 06:55 Warm up on the hill

07:00 Race starts for all categories. There will be a one minute gap between riders.

Sunday 5th April, Road Race

Race details:

- Race distances
 - Advanced and Junior – 4 laps
 - Sport and Ladies – 3 laps
 - Ladies Novice – 2 laps
 - U16/U14 - 1 Lap TT

Course details.

Description of 1 lap of the course. The Race HQ and Start/Finish line is at the lay by at Rocquaine. The race is neutralised on the first ascent of Pleinmont hill, the race start proper will be somewhere prior to the junction by Torteval Church, indicated by the waiving of a Red/White checkered flag. The course proceeds along Torteval Road to the junction with Rue des Farras. The course turns left at the junction and continues through St Peters village to the coast road at L'Eree, The course turns left onto the coast road and continues to the Finish line at the layby at Rocquaine. One complete lap is approximately 7.75 miles. The Youth Time Trial will start and finish at the layby at Rocquaine

The days Schedule:

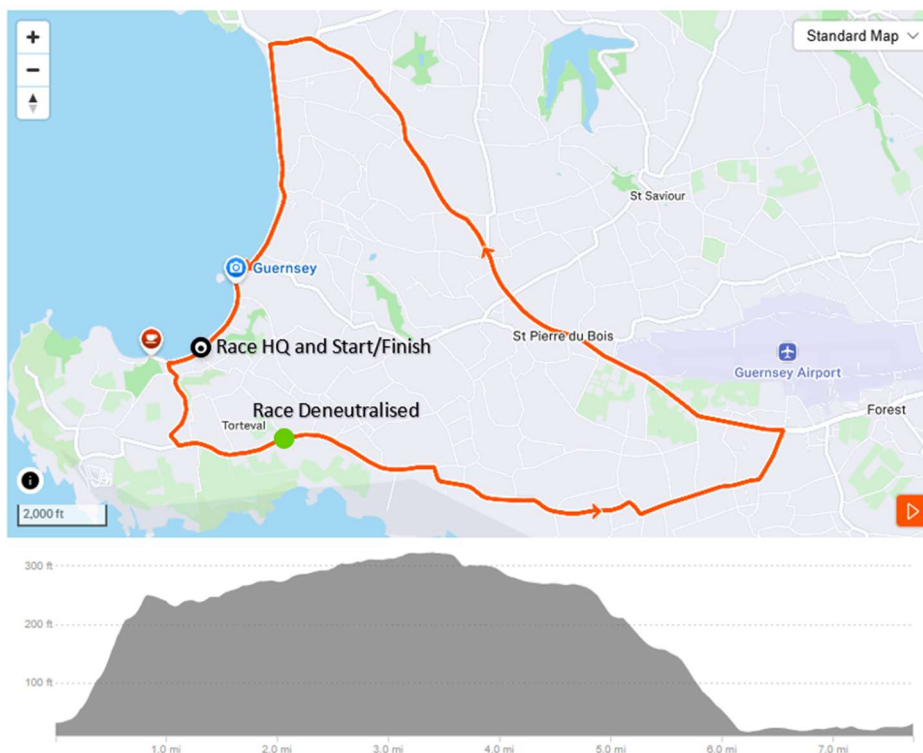
06:30 Sign on opens.

06:50 Safety Briefing

07:00 Race starts for all categories. There will be a one minute gap between the start of Advanced / Junior men and Sport men / Ladies. The U16/U14 TT will start immediately after the start of the road race.

08:30 Last riders will finish around 08:30.

Monday 6th April, 10 m Time Trial

Race Details:

- 10 mile Individual Time Trial for all age categories
- Race Sign in will be in the car park by Mim's Kiosk
- Starting order will be by category: Novice Ladies, U16/U14, Ladies, Sport Men, Junior Men, Advanced Men.
- The starting order for riders within each category will be the reverse order of their overall standing

Course details:

The Start is located opposite the parking area to the NE of the kiosk and about 200 m South of the Filter in Turn junction. The course proceeds South along the coast road for approximately 5.4 miles. Riders will then perform a 180 degree turn at the Southern end of the parking layby, the riders will complete the turn into the layby at Rocquaine Bay. There will be a marshal at this point to assist with the riders making the turn and hold any traffic if required. Riders are to turn in front of the marshal, who may be holding up traffic at the time. The course returns North along the same coast road for a further 4.6 miles to finish just before the junction with the Sous Les Courtil road.

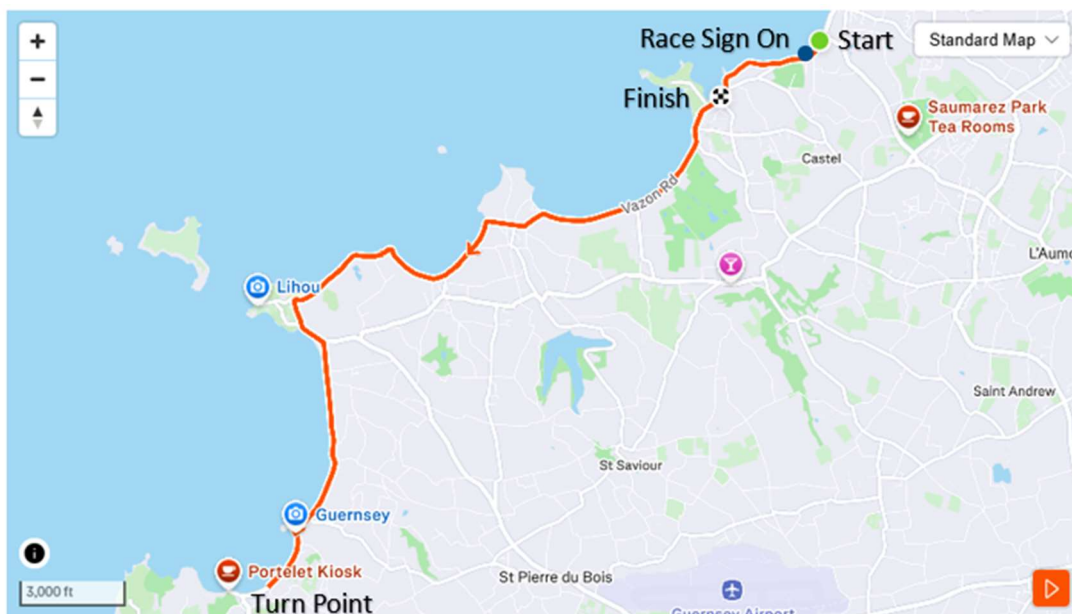
The days Schedule:

07:00 Race starts for all categories. There will be a one minute interval between riders

Prize Money:

Each category (except Youth) - 1st £50, 2nd £30, 3rd £20.

Youth U14/U16 – 1st £30, 2nd £20, 3rd £10

Important Rider Information.

- This is a Road Bike only event, so no Time Trial bikes allowed, this includes no clip-on bars or deep section wheels.
- Riders requiring the loan of a timing transponder should arrive in time to have it issued and attached to your bike. Transponders will be available for collection from the Club van on the Friday
- Riders are required to sign on before each stage.
- Race numbers are to be returned after each race.
- Front lights are mandatory for the U16/U14 Time Trial on the Sunday and the Time Trial on the Monday.
- Rules of a Time Trial. This is a race against the clock with no assistance from other riders, so, if you are caught by a faster rider, you are not allowed to sit in and get a tow.
- The weather forecast is not as we would want it, so dress accordingly.
